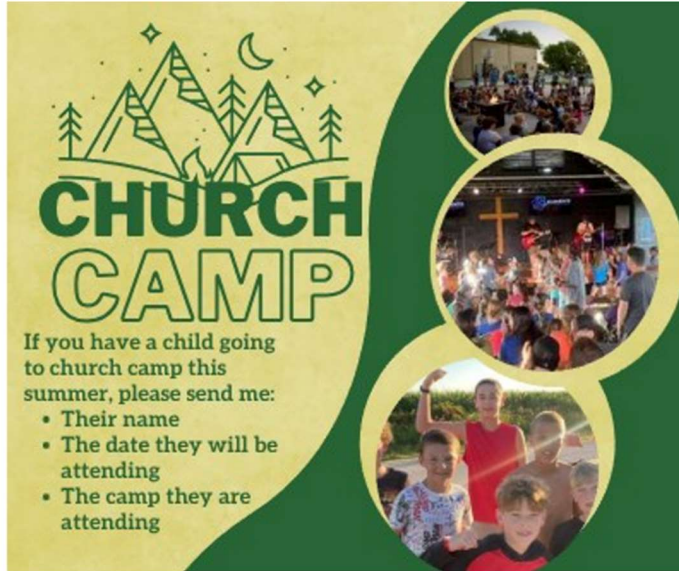

Another Successful Double Portion Event

May 17, 2025

About 10 new meals put in the freezer for sharing!

From the Kitchen of: **Double Portion** (Christ Church of Neodesha)

Philly Cheesesteak Sloppy Joes

Yields: 6 servings

Ingredients:

1lb. lean ground beef, chicken or turkey

1 green pepper, diced

1 yellow onion, diced

2 Tb extra virgin olive oil

1 Tb red wine vinegar

1 tsp salt

½ tsp garlic powder

¼ tsp black pepper

To Freeze and Cook Later:

- 1) Label a gallon-sized freezer bag with instructions and use by date (3 mo.)
- 2) Add all ingredients to your freezer bag
- 3) Remove as much air as possible, seal, and freeze for up to 3 months.

To Cook:

- 1) Thaw freezer meal overnight in refrigerator or in morning in water
- 2) Stovetop: Add contents of freezer bag to large skillet, pot or sauté pan. Cook on Medium-high heat for 10 -15 minutes
- 3) Crockpot: Add contents of bag to crockpot. Cook on low for 4 hours.

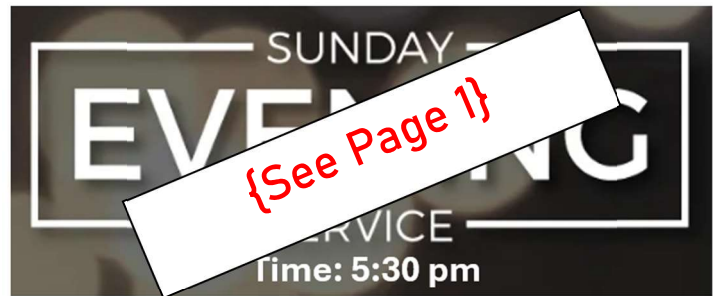
