

First, thank you for your continued prayers and concern. They mean more than I can express. I want to share a brief but heartfelt update on what has been going on here and how God continues to sustain us through both the trials and quiet victories.

Earlier this year, we made the difficult decision to temporarily close the school due to serious character issues within the staff. That decision, while necessary, led to legal backlash. Former staff members sued us, claiming they were not let go properly under Guatemalan law, which requires a long and costly termination process. The legal and financial strain has been overwhelming.

To make matters more painful, our ministry secretary left in a romantic relation with our married main financial supporter. Because our criticism of the affair, he withdrew his financial support and the school closed, many assumed the ministry had shut down entirely. That couldn't be further from the truth.

In the middle of these trials, I began working at another school in a nearby town, walking long distances and living off just one meal a day to stretch what little resources we have. I make the equivalent of about \$2.00 per hour. It doesn't go far, but the ministry continues. We have helped distribute food, supported schools with basic needs, and provided counsel and hope to young people facing unthinkable circumstances.

Our event center remains stable but slow during certain months, adding more financial weight to carry. We've faced dishonesty from past workers, vandalism, and theft, yet we continue to press forward. Recently, we discovered a former mechanic sabotaged our vehicle, trying to create a false diagnosis. It's things like these that make the road feel long, but God has never failed us.

In all of this, I remember the story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. Like them, I've said many times, "My God is able to save me... but even if He doesn't, I will not bow." I won't bow to bitterness, anger, or revenge. Instead, I keep showing up where God calls me.

We need your prayers more than ever. And if you're able to support financially, it would be a tremendous blessing. We continue to trust that God is writing a bigger story, even in the moments that feel like loss.

I have been reading in Ezekiel. In some of the "teen" chapters, the Lord begins to list His grievances against Israel, Jerusalem and their different types of sins. In Chapter 13, the Lord is grieved by the foolish prophets who speak falsely and follow their own spirit. In Chapter 14, He warns against idolatry. Not just physical idols but setting up idols in their hearts. Then in the remainder of Chapter 14 and in Chapter 15 the Lord reminds them that He sees their unfaithfulness. As I was reading, I almost couldn't go any further as my heart was aching wondering how they could have gotten themselves into such a mess. Then my attention turned to the present and I ached for what I see in our country. I was then reminded of 2 Chronicles 7: 14 (which also follows a text of the Lord's reminders of His displeasure with His people): "...if my people who are called by my name shall humble themselves and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear

Being drawn to that verse forced me to become introspective. This now was not just about an historic lot of people "who should have known better." What about the here and now? How am I doing? Am I speaking foolishly and following my own spirit? Am I setting up idols in my heart? Have I checked in with Jesus lately to see what He thinks my meter reading might be on the faithfulness scale?

from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land."

Yes, I continued to pray for our city, our state, and our country, but I was firmly reminded that the Lord's desire and command is that I start with myself.

Then, after the heaviness of those chapters and the time in prayer that they demanded of my spirit, I turned back to my path in Ezekiel and came to Chapter 16 verses 60-63: "Nevertheless"! "I will remember my covenant" "I will establish an everlasting covenant with you" "Then you will know that I am the Lord" "I will provide atonement for all you have done"

Oh, my heart leapt within me! I could see Jesus all over those verses. Thank you, Jesus, that You are the "Nevertheless" in our lives. Our country and our personal lives can have entire chapters written by the evil one about all our shortcomings, disappointments and failures but there You are waiting for us at the end of any such list, with nail scarred hands and outstretched arms saying, "Nevertheless, I will provide atonement for all you have done." We can't ask for anything more!
















