Hebrews 11:6 Hebrews 3:19-4:2

Faith affects your identity. It affects how you see yourself In what you struggle to believe about God, you will struggle to believe what He says about you.

Faith or the lack of faith affects our capacity.

What you believe about God and how you respond to the Word of God when you hear it matters.

You will respond from the inside out, at the heart level.

We see the stories in the Bible and

The unbelief is not about people who were unaware of the power of God. Every plague was a punch in the face to every false God of the Egyptians. They saw God's response in the miraculous. When they got to the promise land they believed an evil report. How they responds shows their faith.

Their wilderness experience was categorized by murmuring complaining and unbelief. They judged God by what they didn't have, not by what God said. God doesn't owe us anything. What He was already doing was more than they deserved.

Everything they turned around they found more to complain about. The human tendency to be walking in the miraculous and have the attitude of complaining. They are free by stuck. Somehow resisting God all the time. A tendency to make idols they can manage. Their mindset is what got them stuck.

Where's your focus. On what you don't have or don't like then on what God promises them. Saved and unsatisfied, stuck because of misplaced focus.

Meditating on what God has already done my heart hears what He wants to do.

James 1:5-8 Wisdom what to do and how to navigate through it. Ask, and do not be double-minded. Easily move by external pressure.

Faith lives from the inside out. Doubt let's the external circumstances change the internal belief.

The wind will.blow but you won't be moved.

You cannot receive from God until you are firm on the inside about Who He is and what He says about you.

"Let us fear" this is serious and reverent.

Reverence is a sign of your belief.

You never grow past reverence for God. His mercy and grace does not mean He doesn't still discipline us.

The attitude of our heart, is important and means everything on whether you receive from God or stay stuck. You have to experience Him from the inside out.

The attitude of unbelief disqualified them from what God had for them. What your thoughts go to when you hear the promises, indicate where your belief is. We get robbed every week and it's because of our our mind amd attitude. We let the devil in through the open door. We convince ourselves that the payoff is worth the consequence. At some point we have to repent, change our mind, surrender the idol ideas we carry around that exult our arguments. "for the pulling down of strongholds", arguments.

You have to have the right mind for God to bring you into the promises. God cannot fight your enemies and you at the same time, someone has to surrender.

Two spies who gave a good report, had to endure the death or their friends and family. When you misjudge the Just Judge you cut yourself off of the promises.

"Therefore, while the promise still stands"... "we who have believed entered into that rest". Make up your mind on what your going to focus on.

How you respond to the Word of God matters. He knows we have to encountered Him to keep our word. Jesus has already done His part. We have to take what He's done and act like we believe it.
