



Like many of you I get lost in the minutiae of things going on in my
life. Then also I know like my wife & me, we have our dear brothers
and sisters in your church family or elsewhere that you are praying for
and try to keep involved in their lives and needs and that sphere can
become quite large and if we let it, it can get a bit overwhelming.

Paul reminds us in Philippians: "Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things." (Phil 4:8)

When we've made all the phone calls. When we've made the visits. When we've texted. When we've prayed. When we've run to the store. When we've made a plan.

"Finally..."

There is a lot that can be said in that word "Finally". Paul is calling us back to a recharge of our spirit and mind. At the end of the day don't forget the "Finally...". It's more than a prayer, it's a meditation, a reset, a reminder.


Also in Psalm 62: 5-7 "My soul, wait silently for God alone, For my expectation is from Him. He only is my rock and my salvation; He is my defense; I shall not be moved. In God is my salvation and my glory; The rock of my strength, And my refuge, is in God."

Strong's concordance suggests that "expectation" means a cord of attachment. That connotation is so amazing. Read that again replacing expectation with cord of attachment.

As we do our "Finally", and we think of these two verses together, are we waiting in that expectation? What a blessing of rest and rejuvenation it can be for us. We will remind (attach) ourselves to all the good things with which the Lord wants us to fill our minds, souls and spirits as well as to build up our positions that we hold with Him as our Savior – our rock, our salvation, our defense, our glory (splendor/honor), our strength and our refuge!

I encourage you at the end of the day to take Paul's "Finally" and Psalm 62's "wait silently" and use them in combination to recharge your spiritual batteries for the day. To refocus your work for the Kingdom. To remind you of all the blessings and wonderful expectations we have in Him!

One more time: Finally...whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.

Update on James!

James has been doing quickly,! He just finished Blina/having his backpack a couple weeks ago. It's been such a relief for him not being attached to a tube all the time. He dealt with a lot of personality changes/behavior problems on it. Ever since he's been off of it he's been back to normal! \(\begin{align*}\text{U}\)
His next chemo phase had to be delayed a week and a half because he's been struggling with his ANC. Thankfully today his ANC was high enough to start his next chemo phase, although he's still has to be isolated because it's still considered very low. With him getting a few different chemo's today we expected it to drop even more.

We're praying it goes up quickly so he doesn't have so many delays in his treatment due to his counts.


We also found out that he needed a IVIG transfusion due to Blina, this also affects his risk for infection. We're grateful there is an infusion available to help him.

His last time he was on this chemo phase, the chemo was very hard on his liver & he struggled a lot metabolizing it. Prayer request during this phase:

- -Protection for his liver
- Good ANC levels
- Protection from all infections/sicknesses
- help with his toe walking and no added numbness to his feet from chemo (could result in physical therapy and braces if it continues to get worse as it has)
- -Protection from any longterm side effects Thank you.

They'll work their gardens and eat fresh vegetables.


And I'll plant them, plant them on their own land.






