
Notes by Pastor Ashley Dodson



Hello,

This is the postcard I sent out with the food bags this week. I delivered food to 8 families serving a total of 22 children. Each family got 1-2 pounds of meat, a jar of spaghetti sauce, a family size can of green beans, prepared soup mix, a large box of instant oatmeal, 2 pieces of fruit for each child in the home, a ½ gallon of milk, and one Food 4 Kids food bag. All families were very appreciative. Three families stated they didn't have food at home to get them through. I know it was a blessing to all.

Thank you to everyone who helped me get this done!





The Neodesha Food Pantry is needing your help. Our administrator is retiring after serving over twenty years.

We have been serving the needs of Neodesha for a long time; and don't want it to stop. It was originally started by the Neodesha Ministerial Alliance and distributed from the grey building at 4<sup>th</sup> & Indiana. In 2007 the Lions Club built the building behind the City Office for us. Several businesses and individuals furnished the contents. It has always been run by non-paid volunteers.

- It receives no government funding.
- All funds are from local residents, organizations, and churches.
- Food is handed out twice a month.

We need someone or group to step up and take over. Barb Griffith will show you how it is run. If you are interested, please contact Barb at 620-325-2702.






