03.02.25 Pastor Joseph: Mark 4:35-41

vs.35 Evening had come. They were already spent and tired, they had been busy. God's always doing something.

It's not that God isn't moving, its that we aren't seeing. vs.36 Jesus acts like your stuff is His. They got into someone's boat. He expects your time and resources and ability to be His when He needs it. Jesus gets in the boat but He's going to make you drive. With Jesus it's take it or leave it, we don't get to tell Him how to ride with us. He feels like a backseat driver but He knows where He's going. He's taking you somewhere you've never been before. A great wind storm arose. Jesus led them into a storm.

The disciples are freaking out, but Jesus is asleep. vs. 38 Sometimes your circumstances can cause you to accuse God of not caring. The text identifies Jesus as a teacher in this passage. The teacher is at rest. The teacher understands this is just an evaluation time. They are involved with the public side of Jesus's ministry but also being led through their private lives. What Jesus is doing in a corporate setting does not make us exempt from following him in private. "Do you not care?" vs.39-40 Jesus stops the storm. Jesus the Teacher asks a question. "Why are you so afraid? Have you still no faith?" He's not asking the question to accuse. He's not shaming the student. Let's take what happened and let's talk about it. I am going to teach you who I am in the midst of the storm. The disciples had a perspective of Jesus that could not contain what He did. They were filled with great fear. "Who is this?" He confronts us and our perception to teach us and train us. The teacher asking the question implies that our focus is in the wrong place. Knowing why doesn't fix it. Knowing why doesn't change it. But knowing Jesus does. The trouble comes when the questions cause you to lose your faith in God. Are you willing to walk with Him and follow Him?







Peggy E. Cheshier

Peggy (Wilson) Cheshier of Neodesha, Kansas graduated to glory in her sleep Tuesday, February 18, 2025 at Wilson Medical Center, surrounded by family and friends.

Peggy's faith in Jesus Christ was the center of her life, and His grace enabled her to have a profound impact on her family and community throughout her

Peggy was born and raised in Russellville, Arkansas with her 2 sisters, Jane and Pat, and her parents, Harry and Leta Wilson. Harry, known to all as "Buddy" or "Papa Buddy" was well known as the owner and manager of the Little Model Cafe in downtown Russellville. Leta was a homemaker and faithfully attended church with the girls. Peggy had started piano lessons as a young child and by age 12 was pianist at the church, where she accompanied the choir and soloists, as well as playing piano anthems for preludes and special occasions. When Peggy was a freshman at Arkansas Tech University in Russellville. she met a handsome Arkansas Tech sophomore, Davey Cheshier, and they were married on August 28, 1950. They both pursued their love for biblical studies and southern gospel music at South Central Bible College. Dave sang in gospel quartets while Peggy accompanied the groups, which were

Benton, Arkansas for a short time where Dave started his teaching career at the local high school. They soon followed Peggy's cousin, Alma Lazenby, to Neodesha where Dave resumed his teaching career at Neodesha High School. Dave was well known as a teacher of English and History, while Peggy held several jobs in town, including marketing and advertising at First Neodesha Bank. All the while, they raised their five children, and, along with three cousins, formed the "Cheshier Family Singers". Peggy made

Dave and Peggy went into ministry as pastors of The Lord's Chapel in 1982, and when Dave retired from teaching in 1987, they continued their ministry full-time until 2018, when they retired. During their years as members of the Neodesha community they helped many people and contributed greatly to the de-velopment of the business, industrial, as well as spiritual culture of their hometown. Peggy particularly enjoyed hosting her many friends and planning all kinds of lavish events. She was known as the "life of the party" and was loved by all who knew her, which was practically everyone! She was creatively energetic and constantly imagined things to do for Neodesha. One example was the establishment of the annual "Home for the Holidays" event at the Neodesha Arts Center, but there are many more.


Memorial Service for Peggy is Saturday, February 22 at 10:00 am at Christ Church of Neodesha, 10th and Elm


