Mark is a crucifixion narrative. John Mark was a cousin to Barnabas who traveled with Paul. Ministry companion and scribe to the Apostle Peter. The scribe keeps the eyewitness account. Marks gospel is the testimony of Peter's account of the crucifixion.

Mark 14:26-31

Jesus is prophecies to the disciples that they will ALL fall away. 51-52 some scholars believe this may have been John Mark. That's just weird.. thank you Pastor Joseph

53-72 Peter denies Jesus. A very detailed account of the failure in Peter's life.

Mark 16:5-7 Go and tell the disciples and Peter, that He is risen. God placed someone is John Mark's life that wasn't willing to just let him go, in Peter. The same consistency in the life of Peter with Jesus, is what we see in Peter and Barnabas in the life of John Mark's life.

It is a personal responsibility to learn the scripture. This testimony is developed on a daily basis in community. If John Mark didn't have a spiritual community who walked with him and catch him when he failed. And who was willing to walk with him the distance we would not have the Gospel of Mark. It is revealed and sustained in the body.

You have to walk it out for yourself, but you do not have to or called to walk it out by yourself.

Break the power of the lie that it's easy for some but not for me. The beauty of the body is that when we are connected properly we are all protected, thriving, and secure.




