Joshua 1:10-17 Corporate Faith and Corporate Responsibility Joshua is preparing the people to take the land of Canaan. Number 31 Rueben, Gad, and Manasseh, tribes that choose the land outside of Canaan as their inheritance, Moses granted them their request. But don't expect to rest when it's time to keep your commitment to help your brothers enter into their inheritance. The wilderness is heavens welfare system, manna, quail, water from the rock, little work but no warfare. That season is over. The promise land is not a welfare state its a warfare state. From wandering to warfare.

Some people just don't want everything that is in the promise. It's okay, no one is mad, it's not a sin, but they were satisfied with settling.

Some people are content to settle. The spoils are great but so it's the warfare and they are content to settle for less. They don't want everything that God has for them. But if you're going to Canaan it requires warfare. You're going to have to fight, but the way you win is only done with God.

God gave them the land to settle in, but He required them to help their brothers to possess the more. You can't set back and do nothing.

Corporate Faith and Corporate Responsibility

There will be people who are content where they are and will not pursue more. A place of contentment. They are living in their more. Just because they don't want more now doesn't mean they will not want the more later.

For those who want the more, it is a sin to stand in judgment of them for not wanting the more.



Every Box Has A Name

The goal of our Boxes of Love outreach is to meet two needs: physical and spiritual.

Two years ago we started encouraging all our affiliate staff to plan in advance which families were going to receive Boxes of Love. In many cases families were contacted well before Thanksgiving and relationships began. This in turn made the follow-up after the outreach more effective.

At least that was the theory. Did it work?

Our director, Bryant Lee, received this report from an affiliate staff in Houston. It illustrates what can happen when each box has a name.

Hello Pastor Lee. I wanted to share with you that yesterday we celebrated our 13th anniversary as a church, and I think it's quite important to tell you something else. I don't know if you remember that last November, we received 25 boxes of Love, and with the extra boxes you gave us, we ended up with 36. Well, let me tell you that this year was much more successful than previous years. I can confirm that of the 36 boxes we distributed, 16 families are now active members of our church. It has been a great blessing for us, and I didn't want to forget to thank you for your support.

I share this with you because it's a joy for us to be able to say that through Boxes of Love, we reach souls for Christ. I know this isn't about who does more or who does less, but rather so that the name of Jesus Christ continues to be glorified.

After years of doing Boxes of Love outreach I am still amazed at what God can do with a box of food.

I just ordered 5,073 school backpacks and supplies for 10 affiliate cities. Please pray for the children to have open hearts to hear the message of Jesus.

Prayer Requests for me.

Almost three weeks ago I started losing sight in my right eye. My retina had detached and my doctor quickly got me an appointment at Georgia Retina Center. To repair it a gas bubble was inserted in the eye to push the retina back into place. It worked and I had a follow up procedure a week later to laser glue the retina solidly in place. This procedure has a 60% chance of success long-term. I would appreciate prayer for it to be successful, that the bubble would dissolve and that my sight would return.

I also have three MRI's on my head and neck area requested by my neurologist relating to the dizziness. Two and a half hours in the MRI. Pray for calmness as I am in the machine.
